## WKF Executive Committee Resolution on the WKF Statutes

In view of the process for the athletes to qualify for the Tokyo 2020 Olympic Games, taking into account that the Qualification Period will start on 2<sup>nd</sup> July, as established by the Karate Qualification System for the Tokyo 2020 Olympic Games and, the WKF Executive Committee has resolved to issue the following mandatory guidelines to avoid any possible misunderstanding:

- The affiliated National Federations are forbidden to cooperate with and/or participate in events which do not comply with the WKF sporting and competition regulations, in particular anti-doping and safety rules and standards, as well as with the WADA Code and standards.
- The individual members are forbidden to participate in open karate events which do not comply with the WKF sporting standards, in particular anti-doping and safety rules and standards, as well as with the WADA Code and standards.
- Individual members are:
  - A) Athletes
  - B) Coaches
  - C) Physicians
  - D) Referees
  - E) Officials
  - F) Members of national delegations taking part in international official competitions
  - G) Honorary President(s), Honorary Member(s) and former WKF President(s)
